Mission Statement

Canons Regular of Saint Norbert Abbey live the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the traditions of Saints Norbert and Augustine. We live a common life "one in mind and heart on the way to God" through celebration of the Eucharist, liturgical prayer and service to the People of God.

History

- 1120 The Norbertines were founded by St. Norbert of Xanten in 1120.
- 1582 Norbert canonized a saint.
- 1893 Fr. Bernard Pennings, O. Praem., and two other Norbertines from Berne Abbey arrived in the Diocese of Green Bay.
- 1898 Fr. Pennings established St. Norbert Priory in De Pere.
- 1898 Fr. Pennings founded St. Norbert College in De Pere.
- 1908 St. Norbert Priory becomes independent of Berne Abbey.
- 1925 St. Norbert Priory becomes St. Norbert Abbey with Fr. Pennings as its first abbot.
- 1959 The current St. Norbert Abbey building completed in De Pere.
